Seminar on National Education Policy 2020, held on 29th July 2025

On 29th July 2025, NDLI Local Club of RCCIIT, in association with IIC and IQAC of RCCIIT, organized a seminar on National Education Policy 2020, where Prof. (Dr.) Indrajit Pan, Dean Academics of RCCIIT has delivered the lecture. In his talk, Dr. Pan showed how NEP2020 is allowing students to earn certificates, diplomas, or degrees based on their stage of completion. Integration of interdisciplinary courses—such as data science, design thinking, entrepreneurship, and communication—alongside engineering core subjects will help students develop holistic competencies. Dr. Pan also mentioned that at the school level, it introduces the 5+3+3+4 curricular structure, early childhood care, and mother tongue as the medium of instruction till Grade 5. At the higher education level, it emphasizes multidisciplinary universities, multiple entry–exit options, academic credit banks, and vocational integration. The policy also promotes equity, inclusion, digital learning, teacher training, and research & innovation through the National Research Foundation. NEP 2020 aligns education with the vision of making India a knowledge-driven economy, preparing students not just for jobs but for lifelong learning, global citizenship, and national development.
